**Directions:** To solve the **ACT test word puzzle**, use the vocabulary word list and **Latin or Greek word root**. Put your answers **INSIDE** the word puzzle.  
At the bottom of the last interactive word puzzle, click "SUBMIT" for the correct answers and the use of each vocabulary word in a sentence. Learn the vocabulary word list below the **ACT word puzzle**.

**Clue:** To solve the **ACT test vocabulary word**, use the definition, part of speech and Latin or Greek word root. **All 12 words come from these three Latin roots: CEPT, CED and CUR.** The correct answers are in the ACT vocabulary word list.

### ACT Test #2 Word Puzzle -- myvocabulary.com

1) To withdraw formally from membership in, or association with, a group, organization etc. especially a political group (verb)

Root CED = go, yield

**C****E****D**

2) The beginning of something; the origin; a start (noun)

Root CEPT = take, hold, seize

**C****E****P****T**

3) A person or thing that goes before; a forerunner; a harbinger (noun)

Root CUR = run

**C****U****R**

4) Able to grasp mentally quickly and easily; with keen insight or intuition (adjective)

Root CEPT = take, hold, seize

**C****E****P****T**

5) To happen at the same time or together; coincide; to agree (with); to be in accord (verb)

Root CUR = run

**C****U****R**

6) An act, statement, legal decision, case etc. that may serve as an example, reason or justification for a later one (adjective)

Root CED - go, yield

**C****E****D**

7) Hastily, often superficially done; performed rapidly with little attention to detail (adjective)

Root CURS = run

8) Any happening or thing coming before in time, order or logic (noun)

Root CED = go, yield

9) Easily affected emotionally; having a sensitive nature or feelings (adjective)

Root CEPT = take, hold, seize

10) A running in or coming in especially when undesired; a sudden, brief invasion or raid (noun)

Root CUR = run

**C** **U** **R** **S**

11) Continued or repeated without stopping or in a way that seems endless; constant (adjective)

Root CESS = go, yield

12) To set free; to release from bondage, servitude or serfdom; to free from restraint or control (verb)

Root CIP-CEPT = take, hold, seize
